



Unlike traditional abductors, Heel-A-Hip combines pressure relief with abduction


Pressure ulcer incidence

THE CHALLENGE




THE SOLUTION



- **Heel Pressure is transferred** to the Calf
- Soft foam supports the calf and suspends the heel
- Low density foam protects the Achilles tendon.
